

VELDWERK

Collective research project outside of the city

Kunstenplatform PLAN B invites artists/collectives to develop an artistic research project in between January and December 2022, that takes place outside of the city in Flanders and/or Brussels. During this trajectory, Kunstenplatform PLAN B offers productional and financial support as well as advice regarding the content of the project.


Veldwerk is a collective research trajectory focused on the non-urban space. The first edition of the project took place in 2020-2021. To this end, Kunstenplatform PLAN B invites artists to develop a research project in interaction with a specific location, history, community,... outside of the city. Together we ask open questions: a search for the value of the smaller scale and how to start and preserve collective dynamics, resulting in a diffuse multitude of micro-investigations.

For the second edition of Veldwerk, Kunstenplatform PLAN B is looking for six artists/collectives who want to develop an artistic research project outside the city limits. The possible shapes of the project and its aims will be discussed together. What matters is that an in-situ dialogue is started with a location and its context from an open and outward-looking perspective. The projects are given a year to develop, between January and December 2022. A presentation moment is possible, but not a prerequisite. Together we will look for a way to communicate the research project to a broad audience, both through the Veldwerk website, and through a publication that will appear in the spring of 2024.

Collaboration and cross-pollination between the artists/collectives is encouraged. To this end, several collective moments will be organized where everyone comes together to eat, talk and think. In addition, you will participate in three reflection moments, sharing your research with a network of organizations dedicated to artistic practices outside of the city.

For the application we expect in 1 file (pdf, audio, video...)

- A proposal of the project/research you want to realize, accompanied by a short text and some (associative) images. If you don't have a specific location in mind yet, give an idea of the kind of location where the project could take place. The text works from a clear research question. The format of this text is up to you.
- A short introduction of yourself or your collective, and portfolio or overview of past projects (max. 4 pages; photos, video, links, resume...).

Our offer

- Productional support as well as advice regarding the content of the project.
- A fee per artist/collective of €5.000 incl. btw for the entire process.
- A work budget (maximum €2.000) that is drawn up in consultation with PLAN B.

By October 26, 2021 at the latest, you will hear whether you are invited to the interviews that will take place on November 6 and 7, 2021 in Ghent or Brussels. Please keep these dates free.

Kunstenplatform PLAN B selects artists/collectives in order to create a diverse, qualitative and challenging group. Everyone, regardless of age, gender, ethnic, religious, cultural background, disability or degree, is encouraged to apply. The selection will be done by the team of Kunstenplatform PLAN B, together with an external jury consisting of filmmaker Fairuz Ghammam and dramaturg and theater maker Pim Cornelussen.
